Without getting too technical, the Magothy Aquifer is the Town of East Hampton's sole source of drinkable water. Needless to say, maintaining its purity is essential. The East Hampton Airport sits directly atop the deepest and most critical part of the Aquifer. You hardly need a scientist to tell you that pumping a million gallons of fuel annually, process. At the end of September, all FAA agreements expired. By refusing further FAA funding, East Hampton can shutter the airport and regain control of the 610 acres of valuable land devoted to its use, reimagining its enormous potential for projects that would benefit the entire community rather than an over privileged and uncaring few.
